Nick is here to minister to all who have need in our parishes. He is keen to be told if someone has moved in and to have an opportunity to visit newcomers. Holy Communion can be arranged for the housebound or those who are sick. Nick tries to take Thursday as a rest day each week, so he kindly suggests that you only contact him on a Thursday in matters of urgency.

As some of you recall Rusper once had a former seafaring parson as Rector. Jim Waters' legacy to this parish has been in my mind a lot lately, because during lockdown I have been

using his personal chalice and paten, which he bequeathed to the parish on his retirement. It is awe inspiring to consider that these sacred vessels probably accompanied him throughout WW2, that sailors from the doomed battlecruiser

HMS Hood on which he was chaplain may have received the sacrament from this very chalice. Jim had transferred to another ship before the Bismarck sent all but three of the Hood's crew to their watery grave, and he subsequently witnessed the sinking of the Bismarck itself.

In the scriptures the sea is synonymous with chaos, the depths are to be feared and in the creation myths of the Middle East were even personified as wild, warring monsters.

Against this background the Gospels tell of a storm on the Sea of Galilee, of Jesus sleeping through a tempest or actually walking across the waves. For the disciples these experiences leave questions 'Who is this Jesus? How can we relate to him?' Such are questions that invite disciples today to get on board, stay on board and, sustained by the sacraments, continue their journey, faithful, even in the midst of fear.

It would be interesting to know more, where did Mr Morgan live and did anyone see the layout? Apparently it could be viewed from a public footpath alongside his garden.

Please note that the legislation that allowed virtual meetings has now ended and face-to-face meetings resumed from 29th June, subject to various Covid-19 mitigations.

Planning – 20th July 2021

Responses to planning applications

<u>DC/21/1427 Land North of Horsham</u>: Would like the amount of electric vehicle charging units to be increased, and waits for the planting scheme to come forward.

<u>DC/21/1219 Southern Loop Road, Land North of Horsham</u>: No comments except it presumes it will cope with the additional loading for electric vehicles.

DC/21/0673 Bluebell Cottage, Prestwood Lane: No comment.

DC/21/1029 18 Gardeners Green: No objection

<u>DC/21/0975 Land south of The Mount Farm</u>: If HDC is minded to approve this application, Rusper Parish Council would like to see improved landscaping around this development to replace what was removed.

<u>DC/21/1174 11 Steeres Hill</u>: Before Rusper Parish Council can comment on this application, they request the following information:-

- How are the applicants proposing to store and remove waste.
- Can the location of the access track be clarified against what is claimed by the occupants of Merrilees.
- How will the track be formed.

DC/21/1274 The Owl Barn, The Mount: No comment.

<u>DC/21/1307 Bull Land Farm, Wimland Road</u>: Requests that this building remains annexed to the main building for habitation purposes and cannot be separate dwellings.

Response to appeal to DC/20/1315 Stud Farm, Capel Road RPC stands by original comment.

Update on planning decisions

DC/21/0467 The Lodge, Wimland Road – permitted MO/2020/2269 Land east of Swires Farm – withdrawn DC/21/0546 Southcroft, Rusper Road - permitted

Council – 27th July 2021

Reports from other Authorities:

 The Local Plan is being delayed because the Government changed the National Planning Policy Framework recently and this

- has led to more work being needed to the Plan. HDC's extraordinary meeting on 28th July to vote on the Local Plan will be postponed until this work has been completed.
- Cllr Hogben is receiving around a hundred emails every day regarding the Land West of Ifield site. Cllr Hogben explained a little about HDC's reasons for including so many sites in the Plan.

HDC councillors were asked if they think the housing numbers will be revisited due to the work needed by the National Planning Policy Framework. Cllr Hogben thinks if anything, more houses will need to be added as the Plan may need to be for a longer period.

Cllr Sallows reiterated that HDC should stand by the housing numbers in its current plan as the Government calculation is guidance only.

Climate Emergency: It was acknowledged that there is currently a climate emergency, and it was agreed that all decisions made within the meeting will have consideration to this. Cllr Sallows explained that there is a Horsham District Climate Change group which is sponsored by HDC, and part of their initiative is to keep the climate change emergency at the fore front of council decisions.

Pot holes: RPC to write to WSCC to express dissatisfaction with their use of resources throughout the parish, using the evidence collected by the Roads and Transport Working Group as well as the videos provided by Cllr Gatt.

Land West of Ifield: There was a meeting with RPC and Homes England on 13th July which was not satisfactory to councillors as there was no clear commitment from Homes England and questions were not answered in a meaningful way. Homes England had asked RPC to take on various assets if the site is developed. RPC declined to consider this unless a full planning application is approved.

Glebe Field: Members decided not to consider proposing an affordable housing scheme to the landowner to secure additional affordable homes specifically for people with ties to Rusper.

West Sussex Transport Plan: There is a new consultation which closes on 8th October. It was agreed to contact the Bridleways Committee to ask for their views for a response (which Cllr Hussey will do), and to publicise the consultation and ask for members of the public to feedback to the Parish Council if there is anything that they would like included.

Police: Cllrs Hussey and Hanstad-Pilcher met with the Police and Crime Commissioner to discuss the various issues affecting Rusper.

Gatwick: It was agreed to support CAGNE's letter to MP Jeremy Quin regarding Gatwick Airport's Future Airspace Strategy Implementation South. The Clerk will send this.

Three year plan: Councillors discussed their plans for the future, and would like to focus on the following:-

- Traffic calming and road improvements
- Recreation Ground improvements
- Rusper Village Hall renovations


