Same Difference

In his memoir *Recollections of a Sussex Parson* Edward Boys Ellman writing in 1906 draws on over sixty years as vicar of the village of Berwick East Sussex. It is half that period, precisely thirty years since my association with Rusper began, so it feels timely to revisit the *Recollections*. I first read Ellman's pithy fifty-nine chapters when in my teens and remain always struck by the contrasts and similarities in rural ministry today more than a hundred years after his death.

Ellman has an interest in social trends and an eye for detail and it is amusing to read for example on the subject of changing fashions that when he was writing only older men sported the 'traditional' pigtails!

At a personal level I feel a sense of connection with him reinforced by growing up in the same town of Lewes as he did and knowing the same outlying villages. While his father was called up from the militia formed during the Napoleonic Wars, mine served in WW2 and later in Aden. By curious coincidence both my mother and his hailed from the same area of East Kent.

Two World Wars, social upheaval, and an ongoing media revolution later, one priest remaining in a single village for decades may seem an anomaly. In a pluralist society the Church of England is considered by many to be an anachronism. How relevant can Ellman be for us today?

The Church of England seemed to be in general as an all-time spiritual low in the early 1800s and the book's chapter devoted to 'Careless Clergy' reflects this. In a Lenten anecdote we are told how Edward Raynes, Archdeacon of Lewes 'gave a dinner party on Ash Wednesday, quite forgetting the day and when he did recollect it he merely ordered pancakes as an extra dish.'

In contrast it has been good to see the manifold increase in devotion and numbers observing the beginning of Lent in recent years since we began having the Ash Wednesday service with imposition of ashes for those who wish at Durrants.

Planning - 20th Dec 2022

The Council met and held a combined Planning meeting and Council meeting on 20th December 2022. Council was asked to **agree** responses to the following planning applications during the council meeting.

DC/22/2227 Lower Langhurst Farm, Orltons Lane, Rusper, RH12 4RN - Rusper Parish Council has no objection to this application.

DC/22/2227 Gotwick Farm, Orltons Lane, Rusper, RH12 4RN – Rusper Parish Council has no objection to this application.

DC/22/0553 Wood End Ifield Wood Ifield West Sussex RH11 0LE – Rusper Parish Council has no objection to this application.

DC/22/1279 Lakeland Lane South of The Mount Farm The Mount Ifield RH11 OLG - Rusper Parish Council has no objection to this application.

DC/22/2202 Cooks Mead, Millfields Farm, Rusper RH12 4PU - Noted that the application has been approved.

Town and Country Planning Act 1990 Appeal Under Section 78 – Emmanuel Cottage, Rusper Road, Ifield RH11 OLN. Rusper Parish Council has no objection to this application but will raise a point regarding the trees in the hedgerows.

DC/22/2251 Cooks Mead, Millfields Farm, Rusper RH12 4PU – Rusper Parish Council objects to this application's location and query the neighbour consultation.

Local Plan – It was **agreed** that Cllr Sallows would email the draft letters to the Councillors for final agreement prior to the Clerk issuing them. **Landscape Interim Report Confidential** – It was **agreed** to continue to the next phase of the report.

Council Meeting 20th Dec 2022

Meeting dates for 2023 were approved and are attached as an appendix to the minutes available at the Rusper Parish Council website.

Climate Emergency: It was acknowledged that there is currently a climate emergency, and all decisions made within the meeting will have consideration to this.

Reports from representatives

Councillors reported as follows:

- Cllr L Kitchen visited the Weinerberger Local Association Group and talked about the delays to the Local Plan.
- Cllr V Hanstad-Pilcher Old Park Mews, Horsham Road remarking of white lines and a 30mph zone and hedges to be cut back have been programmed in by WSCC. The 30mph zone has been left with Highways for their consideration.
- Ifield regarding streetlamps being on at 7pm and it being too dark.
 Noted that WSCC are looking at it.
- Cllr V Saunders reported that the Incinerator has been taken over by QAir.
- Cllr F Maitland-Smith reported that an advert in the Parish Magazine calling for volunteers got one response back. Save West of Ifield public meeting on 21st January 2023 at Rusper Village Hall.
- Cllr G Sallows reported quotes for the repair of the Sports Pavilion are being sourced.
- Cllr M Fillmore reported that a Gatwick Airport night noise consultation is due in March 2023.
- Cllr M Cooke attended the HALC meeting, 2 people have been recruited to assist residents with the cost of living crisis. Ecology Workshops are to be held on 2nd February at County Hall and 9th February at the Ashington Centre.

• Budget for 2023/24 was approved. Precept for 2023/24 was approved.

Next Planning meeting is 17th January and the next Council meeting is 31st January 2023.

SAVE WEST OF IFIELD CAMPAIGN

You may already be aware that Horsham Council has delayed publication of its Local Plan until after the May election. As a campaign group we welcome this delay because we think more time is needed to consider the potential benefits of Michael Gove's recent statements around modifying house building targets. His proposals are currently the subject of public consultation - see link below. We do understand however that the Plan's delay could open the door to speculative planning applications from developers, but without more information it's impossible for us to form a view on how serious this threat is and on the likelihood of a six month delay making a material difference, particularly given the constraints imposed by water neutrality.

Also on the plus side, given the inadequate consultation so far, this delay presents a real opportunity to ensure that residents fully understand the scale and potential impact of a new 10,000 house development between Crawley and Horsham.

Horsham Council's May elections also provide an opportunity to elect a council that most represents the views of residents. Save West of Ifield is planning a Public Meeting in Rusper village hall which will give you the opportunity to hear key candidates' views on the Local Plan and the West of Ifield proposal in particular.
