REMEMBRANCE

Thirty two years ago a little red book arrived in Rusper – nothing to do with the Chinese version, but "The Men who Marched Away", a book about the men on our Rusper War Memorial.

In her introduction Eve Seaward wrote: "It was during the three-minute silence in 1989 that I looked at the names carved into the Rusper Memorial and wondered how many of the younger generation in our village today had even heard of them, let alone knew anything about the men they represented or the families from which they came. Yet these families were part of our village life; they came from the butcher's shop, the coal merchant, from farms

and other local places, they were known at Rusper School, they were blessed at the font, married at the altar, and if they did not 'die in a foreign field' they were buried in the churchyard." Eve herself was remembering her first husband, John Rappaport, who was killed in 1943, less than a year after they were married and before their son was born.

And so began our continuing interest in finding out more about these men, helped nowadays by sites like Ancestry and intensive research by Jean Wood and others.

But then what about those who marched away – and came back? A Welcome Home Party was organised in 1945 at Normans – which must have been very sad for Lady de la Rue whose youngest son, Victor St George, did not return from the war in Burma. We need to know about them too, so now we have a scroll of names from WW1 of men who returned to the village, and we need to do the same for WW11. For some like Joe Jupp jnr the war gave them new wider opportunities or training in new skills. And those who stayed in the village? We had a Home Guard platoon. It would be good to learn more about that so please get in touch if you have any information.

All these thoughts occupied our November Rusper Chronicle meeting with many contributions from those present. At the end one can't help thinking that for such a small village Rusper's contribution to two World Wars was something for which to be proud.

SAVE WEST OF IFIELD CAMPAIGN

Members of Save West of Ifield met Jeremy Quin MP at his Rusper surgery on 27thOctober. We were pleased that he gave us an hour of his time to explain our concerns about over-development in Horsham District, and in particular the proposal for 3,000 new houses in the parish, and the possibility of a further 7,000 houses and a by-pass. Although he didn't feel able to offer us his support, we will continue to lobby him in the hope that his recent resignation from his ministerial role will free him to focus on his constituents.

We also met John Milne and Sam Raby – Horsham Cabinet members – with planning officials, to discuss our more technical objections to the West of Ifield proposals. We covered a number of topics, but everyone agreed that Homes England's proposals for transport and traffic are key concerns. We took the opportunity to counter HDC's belief that 'everyone wants a Full Western Relief Road' (by-pass), and that taking more housing is the way to deliver it.

HDC intend to discuss the new draft Local Plan at back-to-back Cabinet and Council meetings on 11th December. We intend to rally outside the council offices (Parkside) on the 11th – please join us and see Facebook or email us for more details. We expect the new Plan to be published on 4th December or possibly just before. The Regulation 19 consultation period will run during January and February and this is EVERYONE's opportunity to let the Planning Inspector know your views. Again – see our Facebook and emails for more information nearer the time.

You may have noticed that Homes England submitted an *Environmental Impact Assessment Scoping Opinion Request* to HDC – see HDC planning portal, reference EIA/23/0007. Although strictly speaking this was not a public consultation, nonetheless we submitted a detailed response in respect of habitat and biodiversity where we identified many errors, omissions and inconsistencies. Our response is on the HDC planning portal, and our website.
