RUSPER CHRONICLE

When dinosaurs roamed Rusper!

Yes we really did have dinosaurs in Rusper as we found out at our April meeting in Simon Mortimer's fascinating talk. The south of England was covered by a warm shallow sea during the Cretaceous period for the world was a warmer place then. In the Horsham area you would be standing in water as the area was part of a large estuary with rivers flowing in from the north and east bringing in iron rich sediments. In this sea one million years ago stomped dinosaurs such as the Iguanodon. In the 1820s Gideon Mantell, an amateur fossil hunter. started digging in Tilgate Forest, finding many large bones. But in 1822 he (or his wife?) found some huge teeth which he realised must have belonged to a lizard like creature – though it was three years later till anyone believed him. Meanwhile our local hero, George Bax Holmes, became engrossed in collecting fossils. He was a chemist living in Horsham but his family originated from Pleystowe on the Capel road, farmed by his father and grandmother, members of the Quaker community. He eventually inherited the farm and other property and was able to give up the day job and concentrate on his hobby of fossil collecting. A major find was the Iguanodon remains in North Street in Horsham. Altogether he amassed over 700 specimens which were sold to the Booth Museum in Hove on his death in 1887.

In 1835 he went with Gideon Mantell to a pit in Rusper where they found saurian bones – and again in 1853 to a pit in Rusper. So where were these pits? Sadly, he didn't always record where he found the bones though we do know some finds were made at Hawkesborne on Hurst Hill. He produced a 20-page catalogue, but only one copy is known to exist which is in the Natural History Museum.

Mary Day reported a fossilised Iguanodon tail was found during the digging of a well shaft at Broomells Farm in Capel and now lives in Dorking Museum, known as Claws. And Jean Wood had information about another species discovered at Wallis Wood in the 1980s which was thought to be a fish eater – our Iguanodons were vegetarian which somehow seemed a relief to know!

It would be great to rediscover these pits. So there is plenty more to find out –

The Planning Meeting took place on 21st March 2023 at Rusper Village Hall. Agreed responses to the following planning applications

Fell 1x Apple and 1x American Arborvitae (Works to Trees in a Conservation Area) Wayside Cottage, High Street, Rusper RH12 4PX Ref no. DC/23/0439

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council OBJECTS to this application on the grounds that the original application for application DC/22/1695 said that no trees or hedges would be removed or pruned and the Parish Council feel they should remain within the conservation area.

Prior notification for the demolition of existing class B1(c) workshop building and construction of new dwellinghouse (class C3).

Chowles Farm, Lambs Green, Rusper RH12 4RG Ref no. DC/23/0374 It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council OBJECTS to this application as it is an over intensification of the site, vehicle access in and out of the site is inadequate for 6 new dwellings on a C category road situated on a narrow bend and is outside of a built-up area and contrary to the Neighbourhood Plan. The Parish Council notes that there is no water neutrality statement in this application.

Prior Notification for Change of Use of 2no Agricultural Buildings to residential (Use Class C3) to form 5no dwellinghouses.

Chowles Farm, Lambs Green, Rusper Rh12 4RG Ref.no. DC/23/0373 It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council OBJECTS to this application as it is an over intensification of the site, vehicle access in and out of the site is inadequate for 6 new dwellings on a C category road on a narrow bend and there is no water neutrality statement. This application is outside of a built-up area and contrary to the Neighbourhood Plan.

Prior Notification for Change of Use of Agricultural Buildings to residential (Use Class C3) to form 2no dwellinghouses. Prestwood Corner, Prestwood Lane, Ifield, Crawley RH11 0LA Ref.no DC/23/0361 It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council OBJECTS to this application as the vehicle access in and out of the site is inadequate on a C category road on a narrow bend and there is no water neutrality statement with this application. It is outside of a built-up area and contrary to the Neighbourhood Plan. It is immediately under the flight path to Gatwick Airport and there is no public transport available in the area. The Council raises the potential for contamination and refers this to Environmental Health.

Application to confirm the continuous use of land as mixed use, single composite planning unit comprising the sui generis use of the site between 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 9am to 1pm at weekends for Class B2 use (car repair workshop, MOT testing station and coach building/trimming workshop), parking of vehicles (parking for self-drive hire companies; local main dealer cars awaiting sale and transport; storage of plant and machinery; trailer parking; parking of lorry bodies, scrap/mechanically failed cars and general vehicle storage for staff and customer parking) and parking of up to 150 airport parked cars for a period in excess of ten years (Lawful Development Certificate – Existing).

Spinroute Ltd CCM Depot, Rusper Road, Ifield, Crawley RH11 0LQ Ref.no. DC/23/0263

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council previously made objections to the Enforcement Order and the Parish Council have prior written statements to the appeal on the enforcement to the same site which are still relevant to this application. Rusper Parish Council have STRONG OBJECTIONS to the application due to the extended working hours, the rural location and the rural roads. The extended hours run into the weekend where the area is regularly used by cyclists, carriages, horses and the additional vehicle movements is a risk too high.

Erection of a pair of two-storey semi-detached dwellings with garages DC/22/0355 The Royal Oak, Friday Street, Rusper RH12 4QA

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council OBJECTS to this application as it is overdevelopment in a rural countryside location, does not support new developments on greenfield sites, the entrance and exit are opposite existing driveways and on a dangerous bend on a narrow country lane. The Parish Council have read the water neutrality calculation and are asking for a 3 year water usage report to cross check the calculation. Housing need was demonstrated in the NP as being met via existing and planned local developments, this is an unsustainable site as it is an isolated location more than 2 miles from the village with no nearby amenities or public transport, there would be a negative impact on local listed buildings.

The Full Council Meeting took place on 31st March 2023 at Rusper Village Hall. Reports from representatives

Cllr Kitchen reported that some Parish Councils who have a Neighbourhood Plan in place are not guaranteed their CIL payments because of water neutrality issue and the delay to the Local Plan.

Courage Dyers Grant/Procurement

The Council **acknowledge** the grant of £5725 from Courage Dyers and thank them for their support towards the project. It was **agreed** that the completed procurement form will be submitted to the Clerk.

Proposed Expenditure on Transport Consultation

Two Councillors met with Alan Bailes Consultancy to discuss a Transport survey for benefit of the NP process particularly when the LP moves into regulation 19. It was **agreed** that £2500 be granted to the Transport Consultation.

Rusper Sports Club Terms of Reference

Noted there are 2 parts to the document, how it is managed and how that arrangement works. The Council discussed the document and several points were raised. It was **agreed** that Cllr Viv Hanstad-Pilcher to meet with Surrey Hills

Reports from Representatives

Clir Sallows reported the proposal to put an extra D outside of the tennis court with one basketball hoop. Three quotes to resurface the courts are currently being reviewed. Repairs to the carpark and higher fencing around the court is also being discussed.

CIIr Hanstad-Pilcher reported that the WSCC Highways meeting is on 6th April in the Council offices in Horsham. A meeting with WSCC Highways steward was held to discuss parking issues. CIIr Cooke and CIIr Hanstad-Pilcher will attend the Police focus group meeting on 15th May 2.30pm in Southwater.

Clir Maitland-Smith Litter pick on Sunday, 2nd April at 11am – all welcome.

Clir Saunders reported that the mud on road from the North Horsham development do not require any wheel washes from site as there is nothing detailed within the planning conditions. **Action** Clerk to escalate this with County Councillor Katie Nagle.

CIIr Gatt Village Hall quotes for the roof have been received but further discussion whether the roof needs repairing or full replacement is ongoing. The Hope Keith Trust plan to convert the snooker room into a hub. Noted that the 106 money from the Bovis development could be managed within the transport survey and neighbourhood plan meeting and for transport improvement to Rusper Primary School.

Procurement Workbook

The blank procurement forms were distributed in advance of the meeting. Councillors were advised on how to complete the form and how this will enable the Council to track preferred suppliers, track payment and to ultimately sign off the work. The Council were referred to the Financial Regulations as guidance on costs and whether 3 quotes are required.

Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group (NPSG)

The terms of reference document was distributed in advance of the meeting. The Council considered the revised ToR with some changes. It was **resolved** to adopt the adjusted NPSG Terms of Reference. It was **agreed** Cllr Sallows to be the interim Chair of the NPSG until the first meeting. Next meeting 4th April 2023 at The Plough, Rusper
