DC/18/1584 Stafford House, Bonnetts Lane It was **RESOLVED** to comment on this application as follows:-

'Rusper Parish Council strongly objects to this application for the following reasons:-

*The volume of traffic in this rural area will be increased due to this development

*The impact of this would be detrimental to neighbouring properties, in contravention to policies 32 and 33 of the HDPF

*The access to the site is located between two busy junctions, which Rusper Parish Council does not believe is suitable for access at busy periods

*This development is inappropriate for this countryside location, in contravention to policy 26 of the HDPF.'

It was **RESOLVED** to comment on this application as follows:-

'Rusper Parish Council does not object to this application, but would ask that a condition is imposed allowing traffic exiting the site to turn right only.'

DC/18/1693 Scrag Copse Farm, Prestwood Lane

'Rusper Parish Council does not object to this application, but would ask that operating hours are restricted to 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and that outside lighting is restricted to sensored lights only.'
