

If you want to get ahead... get a hat, is the old saying.

As over the years my once luxurious hair has thinned, wearing a hat has become a necessity. Both the *Canterbury cap* and the *biretta* which I sometimes wear have academic significance reminding us that clergy are *clerks* in holy orders. In addition the biretta in particular echoes the black hat of the judiciary, so may be worn when absolving sins, in particular with due solemnity at a funeral.

I tend to wear a *beret* for more practical reasons during rain and on colder days, while the summer months the wide brimmed *saturno* offers shade, a purely practical summer counterpart to the beret, without ceremonial meaning.





SAVE WEST OF IFIELD CAMPAIGN

News updates:

- 1. Horsham Council (HDC) have submitted their draft Local Plan to the Planning Inspectorate and also published all responses to the Reg 19 public consultation earlier this year. The good news is that 370 of the responses were objections to the West of Ifield proposals that's almost a quarter of all responses great work everyone, particularly given how difficult the consultation process was! HDC's summary report of the responses is the easiest way to get a feel for the responses about West of Ifield (policy HA2): Regulation 19 Summary of Representations

 Appendix. We're now seeking legal advice on a list of issues ahead of the Inspector's examination hearings at the end of this year.
- 2. Various Horsham councillors tell us that West of Ifield is a good development because "Homes England are part of government and have deep pockets". But that doesn't fit with the new government's cancelling of various infrastructure projects due to a £22 billion black-hole in the public finances. And given the extraordinary amount of infrastructure needed for West of Ifield schools, roads, new golf course, flood mitigation let alone the new sewage plant that Thames Water obviously are not in a position to fund it's impossible to see where the West of Ifield's funding might come from, or that it could be viable for developers without a lot of corners being cut.
- 3. You may be interested in the issues that Homes England must cover in detail in their **Environmental Impact**Assessment (EIA) as part of any planning application. For example the ancient woodland and Bechstein's bat colonies on and around the site, water supply, air quality, Gatwick noise, and heritage assets. And then of course they must mitigate the

negative impacts - more expense. SWOI submissions are on our website, and submissions from official agencies have recently been published by HDC

here: https://www.horsham.gov.uk/planning/environmental-impact-assessment-public-register.

Minutes of previous meeting - it was RESOLVED to approve the Minutes.

Open Forum - SWOI representative - Reg 19 consultation papers being sent by HDC to the planning inspectorate. Noted there were 1600 responses to the

Local Plan of those 370 were objections to the West of Ifield development in the Parish. 3 responses supported the development and 2 were neutral. PSCO Chrissie Symonds reported that there was one report at Ghyll Manor of trespassing. Residents are encouraged to report any crime to the Police by dialling 101 for a non-emergency and 999 if it is an emergency. One member of the public reminded the Council that there is a Planning Consultation Open Day on 3rd August 2024 from 11am to 3pm at Barnwood, Faygate Lane.

Rusper Sports Ground

It was **agreed** that a formal sub lease will be drafted and raised at the next meeting.

It was **reported** that the Section 106 and the Courage Dyers Tennis Court refurbishment has now been completed and signed off. Thanks were extended to Cllr George Sallows for his management of the project. **Rusper Stores Break-ins**

The issue of the Village Stores was discussed. It was **agreed** that this item is to be raised within the Planning Committee meetings.
