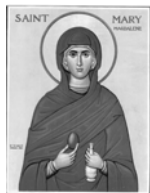

The group also sampled 3 new ales from a new local brewery called Brolly Brewing, based in Redkiln Close, Horsham, which led to a livelier than usual meeting!

## **RUSPER SPORTS CLUB UPDATE**

Thanks to all those who have paid their annual subscriptions to Rusper Sports Club. The good weather has meant that they have had plenty of enjoyment using the refurbished courts. Sadly, there still seems to be some people who aren't honest enough to pay the membership fee, or think they are entitled to play for free and have been using the courts regardless. Income from membership fees is crucial to ensure the ongoing upkeep and improvements to the club: we urge you to join and pay. With facilities available to members for a whole year, our annual fees for Rusper residents are very reasonable - £80 for a family (2 adults and up to 3 children under 18), £40 for an adult, £20 for a junior (under 18) and £20 for a senior citizen. If you are on a low income or you are a full time student over 16 years, the Horsham Leisure Access Card is free to apply for online and entitles you to 50% off the membership fee. If you are not a member and have been using the courts, please be honest and pay up. Membership forms and information on tennis and football can be found at: <https://rusersportsclub.co.uk>

Sadly, after all the efforts to improve the club, there have been inconsiderate people not looking after it. There have been regular occurrences of litter being left at the club (odd wrappers, discarded cans and bottles as well as large bags of rubbish) - please make sure to take your rubbish home with you. ## RUSPER PARISH COUNCIL

Parish Council meeting 24th June 2025

Present: Cllrs M Cooke (Chair), G Hussey (Vice Chair), G Sallows, R Gatt, F Maitland-Smith, G Fleming, M Fillmore, M Fenton.

### Rusper Parish Council Update – July 2025

#### District and County Updates

- *Trafalgar By-election*: Congratulations to Louise Potter (Liberal Democrat) who won the recent WSCC Trafalgar by-election.
- *Waste Collection*: Horsham District Council has purchased 7 new refuse vehicles powered by biodiesel. Full electric alternatives were ruled out due to high costs and limited range.
- *Devolution Discussions*: An East-West Sussex split is currently the favoured option for local devolution among many district councils. However, WSCC prefers a single unitary authority for all of Sussex. Each council may submit its preferred plan.

#### Planning Matters

- A **working party meeting** with Stonebond will take place on **29th July at 6pm at Rusper Village Hall**, ahead of the main meeting, to receive an update on the Millfields development (DC/24/0699).
- **DC/21/1427 – Land North of Horsham**: The Council has requested this application go to committee if water usage monitoring is not included as a condition.
- **DC/24/1835 – Rear of The Rectory, Rusper**: Objections remain unchanged. Concerns were raised regarding tree protection due to changes in the entry layout. The Council supports representations submitted in May and February.

#### Rusper Sports Club

A draft underlease from Surrey Hills has been received. Cllr Malcolm Fillmore will review and bring it back to the next meeting.

#### Gatwick Airport

The Council noted the latest Gatwick report – available on the website.

Pier Schmitt will take over as CEO following the departure of the current Gatwick Chief Executive.

### **Roads & Open Spaces**

- Approved the installation of **Parish Gates on Rusper Road (Ifield end)**.
- Agreed to move the socket at the same time and review SID (Speed Indicator Device) maintenance.
- Updates to the **tree inventory** are underway, and tree-related funding opportunities will be discussed at the next Open Spaces meeting.

### **New Website and Emails**

The Clerk presented the new [gov.uk](https://www.gov.uk) website and email systems. Details of the transfer process are being shared with councillors.

### **Police & Crime Commissioner Survey**

Councillors will respond to Katy Bourne's survey individually.

### **Rusper Stores**

A shop committee member will attend the next council meeting to provide updates.

### **Village Hall**

Work has begun on the new hub. The extension project has gone to tender, with hopes to start in July. The Clerk will liaise with the Village Hall about grant payment timings for the solar panels.

### **Reports from Councillors**

- *Devolution, planning committee changes*, and **Community Asset Transfer** were discussed at HALC.
- Enforcement updates shared; Woodland Creation funding added to future agenda.
- **Bus shelter and phone box maintenance** scheduled; councillors engaging with local residents over tree concerns.
- Changes to national planning policy (NPPF) mean Horsham District's Local Plan is being reassessed. The required housing

target has increased to **1,600 homes per year**, affecting future development planning.

### **Playgrounds and Local Assets**

- Play area repairs completed.
- The Clerk will investigate damaged fencing and clear wood debris behind Ghyll Manor.
- Grass cutting around all **fingerposts** approved.

### **Community and Events**

- Upcoming session with **AiRS** will take place at the launch of the new Community Hub.
- Cllr M Cooke reported on preparations for the next **Old People's Forum**.

### **Finances**

- The Council approved May's financial reports and bank reconciliation.
- Grant payments were agreed:
  - **Rusper Village Hall** (Solar Panels): £5,000
  - **Citizens Advice Bureau**: £100
  - **Air Ambulance**: £400
- Interim VAT return will be submitted by the Clerk and RFO.

### **Next Meeting:**

The next full Council meeting will be on **Tuesday, 29th July 2025**. The Council will **not meet in August**.

## SAVE WEST OF IFIELD CAMPAIGN

### Last chance to fight!

By the time you read this Homes England may already have submitted their **planning application for 3,000 houses** West of Ifield, or as it should perhaps be known, East of Rusper. On 10<sup>th</sup> July a Public Notice in the West Sussex County Times and elsewhere flagged that the application will be submitted after 21 days, ie at any time from 31st

July: <https://publicnoticeportal.uk/notice/planning/686f0562c2a6296aec65abf5>

So the public consultation could start in August, and given the size of the proposal is likely to run for several months.

The important thing to realise is that **fighting this planning application will be our last chance to stop the West of Ifield development.**

### So what is Save West of Ifield doing?

You may have noticed an increase in our media presence in recent weeks, particularly in the local press and BBC Radio Sussex, both to raise awareness, but also to support our latest fund-raising campaign. We need significant funds for the expert advice and professional reports which will underpin the strongest possible case against the proposals. Our planning consultants have produced an excellent “plan of attack”, and we now need to fund its implementation.

Due to your generosity we currently have over £10,000 in the bank, but unfortunately this is not enough. So if you've ever thought " Oh yes, I should donate", **now is the time**. If you've generously donated in the past (thank you so much) and you can possibly afford to give a little more, **now is the time**.

### Is it worth fighting this application?

As I said on BBC Radio Sussex in July, the West of Ifield proposals suffer from several fatal flaws which are likely to have disastrous consequences for residents, both new and existing. And which contravene the National Planning Policy Framework. Not least:

- They put the wrong houses in the wrong place, hence Crawley Councils strong objections;
- Crawley sewage treatment works are at capacity, and owned and managed by Thames Water who are on the verge of bankruptcy. Homes England have no answers as to how the additional capacity will be provided; and
- The transport plans are woeful. A 3,000 house estate opening onto C roads, ie country lanes and narrow residential roads, with increased dangerous rat-running through surrounding villages and conservation areas. It's unacceptable that the planning and modelling seem to have been largely a desk-based exercise.

This application should NOT be permitted. We asked our planning consultants why they were prepared to work with us, and they explained that they feel this is an unjust and unjustifiable application that should not go forwards. And they work with clients who are both for and against big developments – they certainly don't rely on business from us!

### **Making your objection to the application**

We will be running workshops to help residents with their own responses to the application. If you want to do some advance reading please take a look at our Regulation 19 responses which contain a lot of relevant points, although note that the application will contain new detailed reports on areas such transport, hence we need professional input on this.
