RUSPER CHRONICLE

Anyone who likes reading the more popular press would have loved The History Society meeting in June, with fascinating tales of Rusper family lives and deaths.

We met in the church. Not far in the church. In fact, immediately inside the South door, we stopped, and turned 180 degrees to our left and looked at the stained glass window.

Yes, it is glass, and stained but it is brightly illuminated from behind and is mounted on the wall, rather than going through it, so it is not really a window, anymore, although it was a true window in the church from where it came. The back light provides great clarity, so the beauty and detail can be clearly and nearly viewed, commemorating the Trevaskis family of parsons; the son, Hugh was long time vicar of Rusper; the father was vicar of the church of its original location. You decide whether reference, in the window, to "Saint Hugh" imply aspiration or something else.

This prime location in Rusper Church was previously occupied by the memorial to another, a curate, indeed Thomas Smith who died in 1840. He was moved to another fine, possibly even better location in the bell tower. Later, when outside, we saw his grave. Is it unique? It is shaped like ...some say, a Swiss Roll, some say a caterpillar, some say a wartime Nissan hut. You decide.

We stayed inside the South side of the church and to the stained glass window commemorating, not a death or a life, but the Golden Wedding Anniversary of George and Amelia, from Baldhorns in Wimland Road. Is that unique as well? Is there another church window celebrating a Golden Wedding? George looking remarkably like King David, and Amelia looking like Anna the Prophetess from Luke, with three cherubs gracing the corners. Later, when outside, we saw the graves of George, who died three years later and Amelia who survived a further three. And adjacent, the memorial to their three children who died in childhood; were they the three little cherubs in the window?

On the North Aisle of the church is a memorial to the Craster family. We centred on Edmund Craster Craster. We homed on the name, which spellcheck has difficulty to accept. Surely that is also unique? Why? The Spanish tradition is for children to have maternal and then paternal surnames. Is this similar? Was his father married to his cousin? David Beckham Beckham? Taylor Swift Swift? The possibilities are endless.

A wander to the South West side of the churchyard, brought us to a two foot high statue of a little boy. Eric Valentine de Bow, aged four, who was killed by a motor vehicle in Horsham Road in 1933, and whose parents ran the local Forest Stores. Adjacent is the memorial to his older brother Kenneth, who lived to be 79 and only died in 2006. Nearby are his parents, Mum lived to be a hundred.

And in the front of the church near the road lies Margaret Seton Kerr. Born in Calcutta, returned to live with her Grandparents in Rusper, only to die, aged nine in an asylum, possibly from Down's syndrome.

Elsewhere you can find residents of Carylls (Lt General Chalmers), Ghyll Manor (Thomas Dunn) or Seerscroft (General Anderson), all of whom have riveting biographies, that have delighted earlier History Society evenings.

NEXT MEETING: Tuesday 19 July, 7:00 PM Rusper village hall, when we shall be looking at what the newspapers said about Rusper in the 1950s and 60s. Everyone welcome.

Reports from other Authorities

District Councillor Liz Kitchen –Hope Keith trust question – has anybody been appointed yet for the role of village agent? No there is no one appointed yet, but the agreement has been signed.

Policies and Documents - It was RESOLVED to approve the Standing Orders, New Financial Regulations 2024,

Planning Committee Terms of Reference, Roads and Transport Working Group Terms of Reference, all other policies/procedures were approved without change.

Insurance Policy - The insurance policy renewal for 2023-24 was considered and it was agreed that the Council would move their policy to Clear Insurance. Rusper Sports Ground - The Council received a verbal update on the S106 project – Tennis Court. The works are progressing well however someone stole cement on Friday evening but were disturbed by a passerby. Police were informed. The Courage Dyers Grant funded project – the project is due to be completed in the second week of June.

Streetlights The update on the progress of grant funding for the repair and replacement of Streetlights in Cooks Meadow to LED versions was carried to the next meeting.

May Day The Council discussed the future road closure planning of the May Day celebrations. It was agreed that the Council will apply for the road closure but the signage for this is to be organised by the May Day Committee themselves.

GATWICK - The Gatwick report was received in advance of the meeting and can be found on the Council website. The Council **note** the membership of Malcom Fillmore on GACC as a personal member of the Committee.

Reports from Representatives

It was **agreed** that the **HDC Biodiversity** response was delegated to Chair and Cllr F Maitland-Smith.

Cllr R Gat – noted that the new WSCC sign location has to be applied for by the Council however is installation is being paid for by the developer. Cllr Gat to send the information to the Clerk for processing to WSCC Highways.

Cllr S White – the application to reduce the speed through the High Street to 20mph speed limit has been passed to the PSCO for Police section of the application to be completed.

Cllr G Hussey - Noted the shop was broken into again early hours of Saturday morning by a 2 people on one motorbike by ramming the door. Police were called as the noise caused a disturbance but did not respond in time.

Subscriptions were agreed.

Finances - It was RESOLVED to approve the report for April 2024, Internal Audit report FY23-24, AGAR form FY23-24 and the Annual Governance Statement 2023/2024, the inspection of records notice.

SAVE WEST OF IFIELD CAMPAIGN

<u>Planning application for WOI:</u> Homes England hope to submit a planning application for WOI in 2024, ahead of the Planning Inspector's report on Horsham Council's Local Plan. We now know their plans for water neutrality include drilling extraction boreholes – this has come to light in their latest draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report just published on Horsham Council's planning portal (application reference EIA/24/0003) which gives a lot of useful detail on the proposed planning application if you're interested.

We'll scrutinise and respond to the planning application (as we did for the draft Local Plan Regulation 19 consultation – SWOI and our paid experts submitted over 500 pages of technical reports, available on our website). We'll need to fund more work from our transport consultants TTHC, to critique the detailed Traffic Assessment and modelling. TTHC's view of what's already in the public domain is that it contains clear errors and omissions and is based on inaccurate assumptions, particularly about the extent to which residents will cycle and walk rather than use cars. We know that Transport is an area where the WOI proposal is particularly weak, not least because it's almost unique in being 3,000 houses planned with no direct access to a major road. So no wonder that Homes England have had to make heroic assumptions to make it seem feasible.

Local Plan Examination: Horsham Council expect to submit all the Reg 19 responses to the Planning Inspectors after the election, and publish them all on their website. At that point we'll see how residents feel about the Plan, and we'll present this as evidence to the Inspector when we appear at the Examination hearings in October and November, alongside some of our experts, who will also need funding.

<u>Funding:</u> We're launching a big push on funding, to pay for advice and possible legal representation. Please note that 78% of our campaign spend so far has been on expert advice and technical reports, and the balance on engagement, printing, etc. Our May newsletter gives detail on SWOI's expenditure breakdown and a forecast of possible funding requirements for 2024.
