

Something...

old, something new, something borrowed, something blue. So goes the traditional rhyme telling us what a bride should wear. The verse might well be applied to our celebration of the nativity of Jesus, the marriage of heaven and earth:

<u>Something old</u>. It is fair to say that hardly anyone alive on earth, can have grown up without some sense of this story. It may be nothing more than the snatch of a carol tune

or familiarity with a greetings card crib scene, but the homely accounts of Matthew and Luke and the sublime philosophical poetry of John's Gospels endure within almost universal human consciousness.

<u>Something new.</u> In my 25 years in Rusper we have experimented with different expressions of the essence of the celebration, and styles of service. This story belongs to the people. The Puritans tried and failed to destroy the outward trappings of the feast, and more recently secularism may seem to threaten the heart of it but it simply renews itself.

Something borrowed. Christmas is pagan we are sometimes told. Indeed, once the Roman Empire adopted Christianity as the state religion they incorporated elements of their pagan culture into it. Myths of light and darkness to explain the seasons were already celebrated in a cult of the Unconquered Sun at this ending of the year. There was a heathen mysticism around greenery; holly, Ivy and mistletoe, and these became enriching elements of the Christian feast.

<u>Something blue</u>. Among the green and red of foliage and berry, the gold of vestments and furnishings for the birth of a king there is the blue of Christmas. The superficial jollity of a purely commercial enterprise leaves that sense of something missing. It adds poignancy to the loss of those with who we have celebrated and are no longer with us. Deepening financial hardship for many over the last decade the growth in child

poverty has made some families feel failures, because they can't provide the mythical magic of the season in material terms. Palestinian Christians in Bethlehem itself have become a persecuted minority. There is yet also the blue traditionally associated with Mary, the Mother of Jesus, whose sorrows and joys, light and glory are at the heart of the story. The revelation of the union between earth and heaven, God and us, married in the mystery of the Word made one flesh with us.

We were so pleased to welcome so many people back to the first proper indoor meeting of the Rusper Chronicle society since the start of the pandemic, thank you for coming and we hope you had an enjoyable evening. We are now in the large hall instead of the back room, and will be meeting on the second Tuesday each month.

Unfortunately Margaret White was unable to attend, but her very interesting collection of early paintings and drawings of Rusper church in the village going back to the 18th century was presented by Joan Fraser and George Sallows. After that Harold Steere told a meeting about his early life in Rusper, living at Misers Cottage on the Rusper Road during the last war. Misers was originally an ale house probably serving drovers and other travellers going to Horsham; it has not served as an ale house for many years and now has been renamed The Oaks. Jean Wood then filled in the background history of both Misers and the older cottage next-door from old census records. Her research did raise the question whether this old cottage was the original ale house before its neighbour was built.

We look forward to welcoming everyone to our Christmas meeting on December 14.

Planning – 19th October 2021

Responses to planning applications

DC/21/2172 Land South of East Street: Strongly object for the following reasons (the full objection can be seen appended to the full minutes on our website):-

It is on a greenfield site and is unsustainable.

- The site is away from any built up area and more than 2.5 miles from the nearest regular bus service.
- There are no services to the site.
- The site was not included in the Rusper Neighbourhood Plan which has now passed referendum.
- There is no possibility that this site could achieve water neutrality.

DC/21/1020 Chowles Barn, East Street: no objection.

DC/21/1021 Chowles Barn, East Street (listed building consent) : no objection.

Update on planning decisions

DC/21/0460 Baldhorns Park Farm – withdrawn

DC/21/1953 Land North of Horsham (electrical substation) – permitted

DC/21/0977 Hawkesbourne House – permitted

DC/21/1908 Ashfold Cottage – permitted

DC/21/1771 Swaminarayan Manor - permitted

Correspondence

A letter will be sent to HDC regarding water neutrality, requesting that large strategic sites including Land West of Ifield are removed from the Local Plan Review.

Council - 26th October 2021

Climate Emergency: It was acknowledged that there is currently a climate emergency, and all decisions made within the meeting will have consideration to this

Meeting dates for 2022: Planning Committee meetings will be held on the third Tuesday of each month with Council meetings on the last Tuesday each month, except for February when the Council meeting will be held on the 15th.

Insurance coverage: The insurance valuation of the Pavilion and courts of £220,000 was accepted. The insurance coverage will be increased to reflect this.

Remembrance Wreath: A wreath will be bought at a cost of £17.99 and a donation of £25 made to the Royal British Legion.

Winter Management: The Winter Management Plan was approved. A new grit bin will be bought at the junction of Orltons Lane/Langhurst Lane/The Mount to replace the bin that went missing at a cost of £114.84 plus VAT from Glasdon. The Clerk will find out if it is possible to endorse this with the Rusper PC logo.

Joint Action Group: Cllr Hanstad-Pilcher explained that this is a group with representatives from lots of different agencies (Horsham District Council, West Sussex County Council, Sussex Police, Fire and Rescue Service) to discuss issues that may require a multi-agency approach. If councillors want something submitted to the group they should let Cllr Hanstad-Pilcher know.

Queen's Platinum Jubilee: It was agreed to take part in the tree planting and beacon lighting on 2nd June 2022.

Reports from representatives:

- Cllr Fleming has cleaned and tidied the book swap in Lambs Green and noted that the kiosk needs to be repainted.
- Cllr Hanstad-Pilcher has met with the PCSOs for Rusper and Southwater. The spreadsheet of traffic issues was sent into Operation Downsway so the issues are now highlighted.
- Cllr Hill reported that the Electrical Inspection Conditions Report and all remedial work has been carried out at the Pavilion. The legionella risk assessment is being written up. The Clerk requested copies for the Parish Council records.
- Cllr Sallows attended a consultation with Gatwick Airport.
 Gatwick insisted that they did not require any more housing than is already in the current Local Plan as the increase in employment would be more than catered for by this.
- Cllr Cooke reported that the defibrillator has lost its location code, but a resident has offered to replace this. The Horsham District Older People's Forum is hosting a meeting with MP Jeremy Quin so if Councillors have any questions to raise they can do so. Age UK coffee mornings have now restarted.
- The finger post in Lambs Green has paint peeling off of it. The
 contractor who installed it has offered to repaint this for £50. The
 post in Wimland has the same issue. Cllr Hussey will inspect all
 of the finger posts and speak to the contractor to rectify this.

- Cllr Hussey has sourced wood for the chat room in the playground for around £150 and will have this repaired soon.
- New pads have been ordered for the defibrillator. Cllr Hussey is applying for this to be registered on a national network called Circuit, and will also look into registering it on What Three Words.

Clerk's report:

- Horsham District Council requested testimonial evidence to prove the use of Ifield Golf Club as an Asset of Community Value. More than 30 emails were received and passed on, with many more being sent directly to HDC.
- HDC removed fly tipping from the car park free of charge.
- The next Roads and Transport Working Group will be held on Monday 6th December at 7.30pm on Zoom.
- The bus shelters need a little maintenance. Cllr Hill will find out what is needed for the bus shelter by The Star and Cllr Hussey will find a contractor to do the work for this.

Some good news on the transport front. The Horsham Area Community Car Scheme is up and running again! The scheme is run by volunteers using their own cars to transport people who, owing to frailty or disability are unable to use public transport but can still get into a car. HACCS operates over a wide area, enabling its clients to undertake shopping trips, visits to medical, dental appointments and many other places.

After a simple registration procedure all you need to do to book a journey is to telephone 01403 250202 between 9am and 12 noon Monday to Friday. Trips can be booked up to a week in advance and ideally, not less than two days before you wish to travel.

The fare structure is £3.40 for the first mile and 40p per mile thereafter. The volunteers are friendly and helpful and I know many people will be so happy to know that this service is available again.

Our next coffee morning is at The Star Inn, Rusper on Tuesday 14th December 2021 at 11am. Please feel free to join us for a coffee or tea and a slice of something nice to chat and connect with people who live locally. You will be made very welcome.


