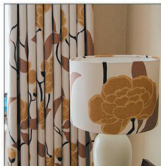

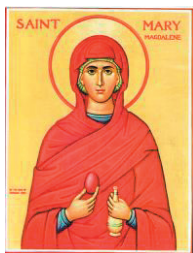

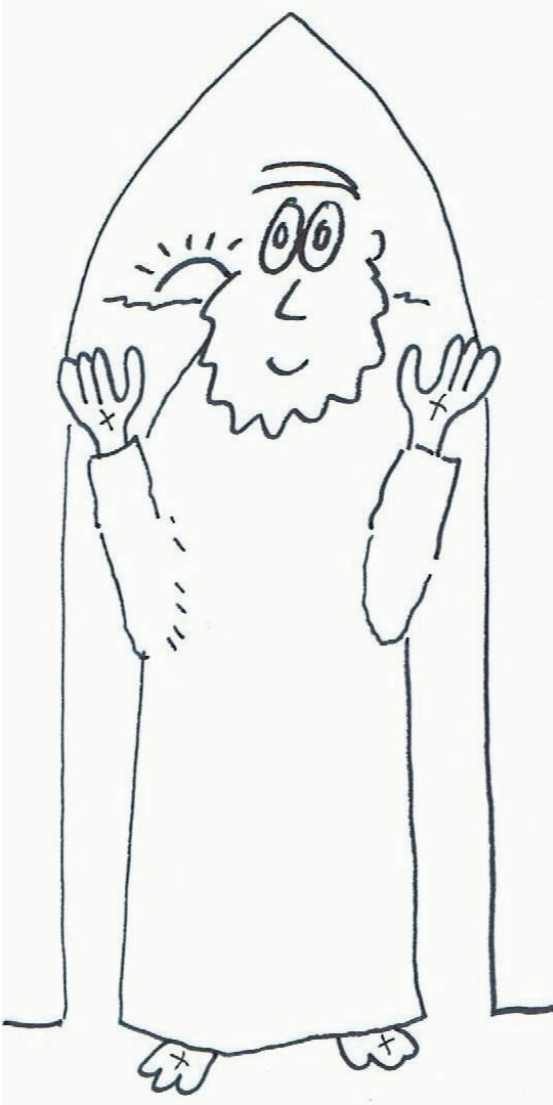

Journey Together



It has certainly been a year of soul searching. During the Pandemic we have also seen the reactions to Trump, the responses to the killing of George Floyd, and as I'm writing this, the tragedy of Sarah Everard is unfolding painfully, and questions being asked about the Police actions at the peaceful vigil in Clapham. This is not the first time, nor, I am afraid, will it be the last, when vainglory, racism and the abuse of male power, among other evils, have revealed themselves, and sadly it is not the last such time that we will be mourning their victims.

Reaching for ritual and performing symbolic actions are deeply human responses in emotionally charged times, and despite the restrictions we have felt the privilege of being the Church and being here for those who are renewing their spiritual search. I don't

believe the Church 'has all the answers' but it is place at once safe and challenging to ask the questions.

As we leave March behind the Church is entering the commemoration of the passion of Jesus expressed in the words and ritual of Holy Week. The headlines of this story are familiar, but we are invited to encounter them in relationship to the pains, passions, hopes and dreams of our own lives. We enter them to find pattern and meaning in our own circumstances. The answers are not neat but bring their own challenges.

I pray that this Easter we encounter afresh and together the mystery of the Cross, with open minds through the open tomb of Jesus.



NOT JUST FOR LENT – Via Crucis- Via Lucis

For many years during Lent and in a variety of forms, the Way of the Cross (Latin Via Crucis) has been a Friday spiritual practice which many at St Mary Magdalene's have valued.

This year as we enter Eastertide there will be an opportunity to continue the journey as the 'Via Crucis' becomes the 'Via Lucis' the Way of Light, with Easter Stations. 12 noon to 12.30 from Friday 9th April.

RUSPER CHRONICLE

The Census

Last month we were all busy filling in our Census forms – but we shan't know what picture it will give of Rusper unless we live another 100 years! However, we know a lot about what it was like back in the 1850s to 1911 from past censuses. Nowadays we do it ourselves online but in the past an enumerator was appointed to go round filling in the forms. Quite a task with many houses in multiple occupancy. Houses didn't have numbers, many did not have names and many addresses were just put down as Rusper Street, which is rather frustrating for modern researchers. Mr. Pigrome, Rusper School headmaster, did one of the censuses, Charles Martin from the shop did 1871 and James Pickard, farmer, of Wimlands, did 1841 to 1861. There was plenty of room for error. The houses are not necessarily in order if the residents weren't at home at the time, spellings of names vary, and many houses were divided up – Averys for example had become three, including a shop.

The first Census was in 1801 though this wasn't much more than a head count. The first proper Census was in 1841 and has continued every ten years since (except during the last war). In Rusper we do have the details of the 1821 Census with added information by the curate Thomas Wood which makes it quite special – he knew all the gossip!

What we do get from the Censuses is an amazing window into Rusper's past. We learn who lived where, who was in their family, what everyone did for a living, where people were born and their age. And, of course, their surnames and Christian names. We often think that people in the village were born and brought up here for generations – and some were – but in the 1851 Census less than half the residents had been born in Rusper and this went down even further by 1891. There was a lot of moving around of farmers as well, most of which were tenanted – it seemed as though the grass was always greener on the next farm. But you can see the decline in farming from the figures. Traders came and went – Solomon Stone set up shop at Averys in 1851 but had soon gone back to Horsham. A butcher came from Norfolk for a few years but then

left, but somehow the village kept going. The Censuses also show up the small traders not listed in Kellys Directory – seamstresses, dressmakers, shoemakers and basket makers for example.

The 1800s was a period of great change in England and those changes were reflected in Rusper – and we can see them through the Censuses. The railway came and we turned into an industrial nation – there was a way out of the village!

REFERENDUM: THURSDAY, 6th MAY 2021

It's been several months since the Rusper Neighbourhood Plan passed independent examination (this is the last step before the community votes on it in a referendum). Unfortunately, voting had to be postponed because of the Covid-19 pandemic but has now been scheduled for **6th May**.

If more than 50% of votes approve the Plan, it will become a core planning document used by both Rusper Parish Council and Horsham District Council. Since the Plan was approved by the independent examiner, it has already been influential in planning decisions made by Horsham District Council.

Summary of Rusper Parish Council meeting & Planning Committee meeting – February 2021

*The full Minutes of this and all other meetings are available to view on the Rusper Parish Council website rusper-pc.org.uk/meetings. These Minutes are **draft and subject to change** until they have been confirmed at our next meeting.*

These meetings were held virtually due to the pandemic.

Planning – 16th February 2021

Open Forum: Mr Nordgreen from Proseed Capital gave a presentation on a master plan for Stud Farm, Capel Road. The plan is for a mixed used residential, equestrian and commercial site (as it currently is) but redesigned so that the different uses are segregated. There are 11 additional housing units proposed. There are already 9 residential units on site/approved. Councillors asked various questions and explained the current position with the Neighbourhood Plan.

Agreed responses to planning applications:

DC/21/0066 Land North of Horsham: Request that the applicants take into account the dark skies policy in the Rusper Neighbourhood Plan and ensure that the affordable housing need is met in future stages of the development.

DC/20/2544 Tamesa, Whitehall Drive: No objection.

DC/21/0103 The Frog and Nightgown: No objection.

DC/21/0164 Croft Garden, Horsham Road: No objection.

DC/20/2324 Rusper Road junction with Arthur Road: No objection but would request that some form of planting is added alongside the fence to make less visual impact.

Update on planning decisions:

DC/20/2337 Friday Farm, Friday Street – permitted

DC/20/2052 Friday Farm, Friday Street – permitted

DC/20/2523 Curtis Farm, Green Lane – permitted

DC/20/2524 Curtis Farm, Green Lane – permitted

DC/20/2465 Land adjacent to Pucks Croft Cottage – refused
DC/20/2460 15 Gardeners Green – permitted
DC/20/2454 Land south of East Street – refused

Council – 23rd February 2021

Trees: Two oak trees in the car park will be deadwooded at a cost of £280. Ivy will be removed from trees at no cost.

Report from other Authorities: Cllr Hogben updated on the Horsham Local Plan as follows:-

- The Horsham Local Plan has been delayed mostly due to the duty to cooperate, which has been requested by Worthing District.
- The housing numbers in the Plan are likely to go up.
- The sites at Land west of Ifield, Buck Barn and Rookwood are looking more favourable due to sustainability.
- Crest Nicholson has not applied for additional homes at the Kilnwood Vale Site.
- The issue with the Mayfield site is that the developers don't own all of the land.

Cllr Kitchen reported that WSCC is looking at going out to consultation on whether to introduce an appointment system at refuse sites.

Operation Watershed: Drainage works at The Mount at a cost of £13,029.75 plus VAT were approved.

Rusper Village Hall: Cllr Bender was appointed to the Rusper Village Hall Committee as a representative of the Parish Council.

Donations:

- a. £200 to Rusper Village Hall
- b. £200 to Rusper Parish News

Rusper Help website: Payment of the domain at a cost of £32.39 was approved.

Reports from representatives:

- Cllr Bender has noticed some work taking place on the pine trees on the Martin Grant development and wanted to ensure that these cannot be removed. The Clerk will ask HDC if it is possible to have Tree Preservation Orders put on these and the oak trees in the site.
- Cllr Bender reported that a stile is missing on a footpath in Ifield Wood. The Clerk has reported this to WSCC, who are liaising with the relevant landowner.
- Cllr Bender has noticed someone litter picking with their child in Ifield and many people throughout the parish have been collecting litter. The Council is grateful to these members of the public and the Clerk will publish thanks on the website/social media.
- Cllr Cooke reported that there have only been two requests for help collecting prescriptions via the Rusper Help hub. It was noted that residents have been extremely grateful for this service.
- Cllrs Gatt and Adams attended the North Horsham PC Liaison meeting. More parking and electric charging points were requested. They raised the point about speed limits within the estate and were told that if it is unadopted it can be any speed. Most of the roads are planned to be unadopted. The single lane closure on the A264 was completed within 4 days. The refuse collection points were also raised as there was concern about how the big lorries would get into the estate. This has been digitally tested for a fire engine so it shouldn't be an issue. The developers haven't finalised the street light plans.
- Cllr Fillamore is now a trustee of the Courage Dyer Recreational Trust.
- Cllr Sallows is trying to arrange a meeting with the Sports Club.
- Cllr Sallows reported that local woodlands are being damaged by the amount of walkers using them and so is trying to set up a conservation project with local landowners. Cllr Sallows will bring more information to the next meeting.
