Should we leave our old magazine to wither away or deliberately archaic though my choice of word is should we reimagine whither it could go next? Who might step into voluntary roles as these become vacant?

RUSPER CHRONICLE

PUTTING PEN TO PAPER

"On this day" so start many entries in Thomas Marchant's diary, kept from 1714 to 1728, the diary of a yeoman farmer in Hurstpierpoint but related by marriage to the Stone family living at Rusper Nunnery. We know about the weather, what crops were being grown, what things cost, where he dined and who with - and what he drank (quite a lot!), how often he had his head shaved beneath his wig and when it was his birthday. A single sentence records the birth of a new daughter – he and Elizabeth had eleven children but only a handful survived. It is a real picture of everyday life three hundred years ago, a life like that lived at the Nunnery by his Mother Stone and Father Stone as he called them. He wrote the diary almost every night – by candlelight with a guill pen – an amazing labour but the result much enjoyed by us. Sadly his son Willy, studying at Oxford and destined to be Rector at Rusper died suddenly from smallpox for which there was no cure – so we found out that Turkey was ahead of Edward Jenner in immunisation. while here the only prevention was Variolation, injecting pus from the spots of someone with the disease – not very pleasant, but history does take us on unexpected excursions at times. Here in Rusper we don't have a diary like that of Thomas – or do we,

Here in Rusper we don't have a diary like that of Thomas – or do we, hidden away somewhere? But we do have firsthand accounts of other lives lived in Rusper such as Curate Thomas Smith's notes on parishioners between 1820/1840, young Len Adams pre WW1 reminiscences of his childhood, and now our own Rector's book; A Tithe of Rosemary. Many thanks to Nick, George, Hazel and Brian and everyone who contributed to an enjoyable evening.

SAVE WEST OF IFIELD CAMPAIGN

Congratulations to everyone who managed to submit a response to Horsham Council's Local Plan (Reg 19) consultation – the system was far from straightforward!

The Save West of Ifield campaign submitted technical responses on eleven policy areas and you can read the reports here on our website https://www.savewestofifield.co.uk/

Many of these reports would not have been possible without your ongoing generosity. Your donations have paid for invaluable professional advice, and we're very pleased with the results and confident that the West of Ifield proposal is not viable, and will be found not sound in planning terms. The decision about the Local Plan now rests with the Planning Inspector – their examination process will run until at least the end of the year and we will try to have a place at the table for all the Examination Hearings in the autumn.

There is also a chance that Homes England will submit a planning application for the West of Ifield in the summer and we will need to be ready for that. Which means unfortunately that we must keep working on all aspects of the campaign, including asking residents for donations so that we can pay for the expert planning advice needed to explore and challenge the detail in the planning application.

If you're impressed by the reports we've produced so far, then please consider donating so that we can respond to the detail in any Homes England application, and so that we can prepare for the Inspector's Examination Hearings. And it would be great if you could support the campaign by attending one or more of our events.

Summary of Rusper Parish Council extra meeting, full Parish Council meeting & Planning Committee meeting – February 2024

Present: M Cooke (Chair), Cllrs G Hussey (Vice Chair), M Fenton, G Sallows, S White, M Fillmore, F Maitland-Smith, G Fleming, E Kitchen (HDC), T Hogben (HDC).

Declaration of Interests - Two declarations made.

Climate Crisis - The Council **acknowledged** that there is currently a climate crisis, and to ensure that all decisions made within meeting have consideration to this.

Minutes of previous meeting - it was RESOLVED to approve the Minutes of the combined Council meeting held on 30th January and the extra Parish Council meeting to discuss the Local Plan Regulation 19 Consultation on 13th February 2024.

Open Forum - noted the hedge cutting in Rusper Road had also cut a white post which needs to be replaced.

Reports from other Authorities -District Councillor Tony Hogben – Kingsfold have put in planning applications, Thakeham Homes at Buck Barn have put in planning applications and are proposing to build 2 reservoirs. The District Council has applied to make some of Rusper greenbelt again. There is a byelection in Southwater and Henfield following the passing of its Councillor. Budget - District Council tax is going up, car parking is going up, green bin waste going up as well as season tickets. Money going into the refurbishment of Capitol Theatre.

District Councillor Liz Kitchen – 600 representations on the Local Plan and 57 from west of Ifield so far, it is being considered that HDC Planning Committees are to have a major and minor Committee rather than North and South committee.

Active Planning Applications

The Council **agreed** to meet Stonebond at Rusper Village Hall on Tuesday 5th March 2024 at 4pm prior to the public consultation re Millfields Development. DC/24/0237 Barn South East of Normans East Street Rusper Horsham West Sussex RH12 4RD – objection.

DC/24/0236 Normans East Street Rusper West Sussex RH12 4RD – objection. North Horsham Development signage - it was **agreed** to use the gated sign, signage to include wording - Rusper and underneath *Protect this Rural Area*.

Reports from Representatives

Cllr G Fleming – clearing the phone box of mouldy books.

Cllr S White – new battery for the SID received.

Cllr M Fillmore – Sussex Local Nature Recovery strategies seminar attended - further information will be on the Parish Council website.

Cllr G Hussey – Information Counter Terrorism Security Unit seminar attended, the new local PCSO is in training. Noted vehicle damage to The Star pub by an HGV. Noted Rusper Stores was burgled twice.

Cllr M Cooke – dead tree in Parish Car Park has now been removed.

Cllr G Sallows – Rusper Sports Recreation is fully booked. Refurb works to start on the second tennis court.

Streetlights – Council to conduct a neighbour consultation to replace the lighting in Cooks Meade.

Local Plan Regulation 19 Consultation - The response was agreed by Council the full response has been uploaded onto the Parish Council website.

Rusper Sport Club - It was **agreed** to request a grant for the maintenance works to the existing tennis court.

Gatwick - Reports sent in advance of the meeting and is published on the website.

Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group - Thanks to residents who helped the Council with the Local Plan response.

Emergency Planning - The webpage to address emergency planning was presented, agreed and published.

Playground Inspection Report - It was **agreed** to find quotations to replace the playground equipment and repair slates in the bench.

<u>Annual Liter Pick - Community Liter Pick 24th March 2024 at 10am at the</u> Recreation Ground. All welcome.

Financial - It was RESOLVED to approve the report, including the bank reconciliation and the schedule of payments.
