Our Harvest Saint

The October feast of Saint Wilfrid brings us face to face with a larger-than-life character. He was the first Christian missionary to make an impact on the South Saxons, the stubbornly heathen tribe who inhabited this part of the world thirteen centuries ago. This month we also keep the feast of Francis, a saint of a very different character from Wilfrid. Even to those with no great interest in the church he remains an attractive personality with a modern message of care for creation.

The two of them represent contrasting aspects in Christianity that we might picture as deep underground springs of spirituality, both vital to Christian life, but sometimes hidden, waiting to be stimulated by events above ground. There is the charismatic simplicity of the free spirit Francis and the rather more

worldly, some might say, realistic relationship to power exercised by the canny Wilfrid. Both streams are needed at different times and to keep balance. Three years of drought had reduced the South Saxons to starvation and despair. We are told the day of Wilfrid's arrival was marked by the falling of rain on the parched ground, symbolising the return of life. Soon, assisted by his priests Eappa, Padda, Burghelm, Eddi and Oiddi he would be baptising in the fresh flowing waters the south Saxons into their new found faith. I wonder if some of their names live on in the landscape as Yapton, Edburton and Pagham? Just as rainfall was not an instant wonder solution, it would be many months before harvest. Similarly, it would take time for them to encounter the message of Jesus in greater fullness. So Wilfrid taught them how to make nets and catch the harvest of the sea.

RUSPER CHRONICLE

We are now into our winter programme. Hopefully all the meetings will now be in the large hall – this is easier if we have a lot of exhibits or wish to show slides. Our next meeting will be held on the 11th October at 7 pm. At present we are trying to find out more about the families that lived in or around the village and are buried in our churchyard; where they lived and how they made their living; have they any relatives living today? Do get in touch if there is anyone you would like to hear more about or if you can help us with information, particularly photographs or family letters. Also we would love ideas for further meetings, please come and support us.

Mowbray Village, part of the new North Horsham Development is now starting to take shape at the foot of Hurst Hill as I am sure everyone has noticed (especially if you tried to access the A264 at school times!). This development seems to have been named after the Mowbray family. The family had strong ties with the de Braoses by marriage. William de Braose was the friend of William the Conqueror and given the Rape of Bramber after 1066 for his help and support. This land, stretching from Bramber in the south, to the Surrey border just north of Rusper village, was held by William de Braose and his heirs for the Crown. It is thought that there was a hunting park stretching from below the Rusper to just north of Horsham town in the 12 th century and it is likely that many Norman lords and even royalty may have hunted the newly imported fallow deer there as well as in the neighbouring St Leonards Forest.

One of the early Mowbray lords, Geoffrey de Montbray Bishop of Courtance, was not only a high churchman and a personal friend of William 1st , but an early enthusiast in breeding and importing these deer. Perhaps the fallow deer living in St Leonards forest today are descended from the Mowbray deer. We look forward to seeing you at our meetings and helping us to understand the history of our village.

Planning – 16th August 2022

Responses to planning applications

DC/22/1304 Winterfold Farm, Wimland Road, RH12 4QU.

- Variation to allow for the mobile home to remain for an additional three years. This does not seem to be a temporary issue. However, if HDC are minded to accept this, then there should be an additional clause added that this should only remain as long as there are brood mares on site that require this level of attention.

DC/21/1071 The Granary, Hawkesbourne Farm, Rusper Road, RH12 4QR.

- A comment objecting to the proposal was added to the planning portal in error.

DC/22/1354 Emmanuel Cottage Rusper Road Ifield Crawley West Sussex RH11 0LN

- The proposal includes the removal of a substantial old established tree and some hedgerow - the council arboriculturist should be asked for their views. Water neutrality statement should be included

DC/22/1452 8 Cooks Mead Rusper Horsham West Sussex.

- The rear extension is pretty much in line with other similar extensions in this road. The immediate neighbours should be asked for their views.

DC/22/1422 12 Cooks Mead Rusper Horsham West Sussex.

- This is an application for replacement of a conservatory with integrated extension. As there is no real change for neighbouring properties there is no reason to object.

DC/22/1525 Orchards East Street Rusper Horsham West Sussex

- The proposal to reduce this to 5m seems excessive and would leave just a tree stump. The tree is showing signs of stress, but does not appear to be excessive at this stage. RPC objects to this proposal as it stands. It needs to be referred to Horsham Council's arboriculturist.

Council Meeting 30th Aug 2022

Traffic Calming on Hurst Hill between North Horsham and Rusper

The communications between Cllr Nagel and the County Highways Team indicated that the Rusper traffic surveys, required by the North Horsham Developer were likely to commence in the Autumn following the completion of the A264 roundabout and the new development access roundabout on Rusper Road.

Traffic narrowing points were meant to be in place on Hurst Hill and agreed as part of the North Horsham planning process. Rusper Parish Council Clerk will write to Horsham District Council to ask when these works will be done.

Volunteer litter pick and road sign cleaning

Cllr Maitland-Smith will proceed with a proposal to look at methods to recruit, coordinate and communicate with volunteers who would like to help out in the community.

Correspondence/Consultations/Reports/Meetings

Rusper Parish Council would like to acknowledge and thank the PCSO for much improving the policing in Rusper. A letter to this effect will also be sent to his managers.

Reports from representatives

- Cllr Fleming cleaned and reorganised the phone box library
- Cllr Gatt had a first meeting with the Village Hall Committee.
Contractors have inspected the roof from the loft space and a scope of works is being worked up.
- Cllr Cooke advised there will be a speed watch day on the 6th September.
- Cllr Saunders had nothing to report
- Cllr Maitland-Smith reported on the Horsham District Council's water neutrality meeting for Parish Councillors. A lot of the focus of that meeting is how does water neutrality affect planning decisions. There were a few discussion points including constraints in the short and medium term and whether water used in construction is taken into account. Also, noting that there is not much in terms of a strategic solution to reduce water usage.
- Cllr Sallows: Had discussions with Sports and Social Club on the constitution and he will prepare a report to discuss at the September Parish Council meeting
- Cllr Hanstad-Pilcher had a discussion with Highways who had agreed to do a survey of the Parish looking at road safety, pot holes etc. This has been done and he will meet them again to look at the findings and report back to the Council.
- Cllr Hussey explained the defibrillator at the Village stores will be away for servicing for 3 days from 21 September. The Ambulance service will be notified of this. There is an alternative at the Village Hall but access

is not always possible as the Village Hall is only open when in use. The village stores do have a key for the Village Hall. He also advised that the monitoring officer will be running workshops on code of conduct for Parish Councils and the councillors are encouraged to attend.

SAVE WEST OF IFIELD CAMPAIGN

We understand that Homes England will be holding public consultation events during October. We hope these will provide new information on the proposals for up to 10,000 houses and a bypass in Rusper parish. At time of writing the dates and venues were not known, but previously these have taken place in Rusper and Ifield.

Everyone should be invited to attend and to respond to the consultation. But please note that **any responses to Homes England will NOT count as objections to HDC or the Planning Inspector**. So please make sure you also respond to Horsham District Council's Regulation 19 consultation which will run for six weeks after publication of the Local Plan. The publication date is not known, pending further work on water neutrality, but there's a good chance it will be in the next couple of months. 
