



RUSPER CHRONICLE

"One of the most daring daylight raids of World War Two".

On the 30th January 1943, two forces of Mosquito bombers were detailed to attack Berlin, one in the morning and the other during the afternoon, to disrupt celebrations in Berlin and a speech by Goering. Three mosquito planes set off from RAF Marham at 08.45 under low cloud. The pilot of the third plane was Anthony Wickham, a young man from Rusper. For his part in the raid Anthony was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross. The Citation in the London Gazette speaks of the calm courage, resolution and endurance displayed by the officers and airmen taking part in the raid. All returned safely.

In February 1944 Anthony took part in another legendary Mosquito raid, Operation Jericho. Now a Flight Lieutenant and attached to the RAF's Film Production Team, the raid was filmed from his plane, with the commentator saying that as the aircraft flew over the target the pilot could see men running through a large hole where the wall had been breached and inside the prison he could see many others in brown dungarees running for the hole in the wall. The pilot/commentator was Anthony Wickham and the film was shown on Pathe News. He returned safely from the raid.

His story does not have a happy ending however. Less than four months later in June 1944 Anthony Wickham was killed coming into land after a routine training flight when one of his Mosquito's two engines failed and the plane crashes just beyond the airfield.

Anthony came to live at Averys, Rusper, when he was ten years old. He loved fast cars -and noisy ones as at the age of 20 he was fined ten shillings for driving a car with an inefficient silencer. Just before the war he was farming at Kingscote, near Tetbury Gloucestershire, but was quick to join the RAF Volunteer Reserve and was gazetted Leading Aircraftsman in 1941, initially flying Spitfires before transferring to Mosquitoes, amazing small two seater planes made of wood and fabric and nicknamed "Wooden Wonders".

Anthony's mother lived at Averys till her death in 1959. Anthony is buried in Rusper Churchyard with a War Graves stone next to his father, Colonel Wickham, who died in 1927. The grave is the closest it can be to the then boundary of Averys, with a small gate from Averys garden into the churchyard. Mrs Wickham must have visited the grave many times. His name is on our War Memorial and also on the memorial at Kingscote, Gloucestershire.

Anthony's story was the focus of our March Chronicle meeting, researched and written by James White and presented and read by George Sallows. It was a fitting tribute to a very brave young man. He was thirty one years old.

Agreed responses to the following planning applications

DC/23/0244 New Barn Farmhouse, Office Capel Road Rusper West Sussex RH12 4PZ.

Prior Notification for partial Change of Use of existing barn to residential (Use Class C3) to form 3no. dwellings.

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council objects to this application. RPC has responded before with serious concerns about the over development of this site and nearby sites in a non-sustainable location far from local amenities and with no public transport on a narrow country lane. We would suspect the objections that led to the refusal of DC/20/1315 to apply equally to this application. We are also concerned that having just receive permission as an equine business they are now saying that the usage is no longer applicable.

DISC/23/0021 The Owl Barn The Mount Ifield Crawley West Sussex RH11 0LF. Approval of Details Reserved by Condition 2c for the approval of application DC/21/1274

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council has no objection to this application and we will leave the decision to the Environmental Officer.

DC/23/0115 Furlong Farm Rusper Road Ifield West Sussex RH11 0LN. Change of use of land for use as storage for scaffolding equipment (Retrospective).

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council have no further comments but concur with the statements from Environmental Health, re: storage only, limited hours and no lighting.

DC/23/0114 Ghyll Manor Hotel High Street Rusper Horsham West Sussex RH12 4PX.

Replacement of front boundary wall. Demolition of conservatory and erection of single storey front, side, and rear extensions to the main building.

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council has no objection to this application and would welcome the re-establishment of this important employment, hotel and venue for the village. We do have concerns about external lighting and would expect all external lighting would be low level and conform to the NP dark skies policy.

DC/23/0085 Coombers Farm Wimland Road Faygate West Sussex RH12 4SR.

Demolition of agricultural work-shop and erection of a detached single storey dwelling.

Noted one email of support prior to the meeting from a resident.

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council has no objection to this application provided previous conditions are maintained.

DC/23/0069 Former Longfield House East Street Rusper West Sussex. (Erection of two detached dwellings and garages (to the rear of the site) and revisions to approved dwelling (permitted under DC/12/0353 dated 16/04/2012)

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council objects to this application the comments for the original application DC/14/0413 still apply and the proposed increase in size will increase the impact.

DISC/23/0047 Winterfold Farm Wimland Road Rusper West Sussex RH12 4QU.

Approval of details reserved by condition 3, 4, 5, 7 and 8 to approve application DC/20/0937.

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council has no objection to this application.

Next planning meeting is 21st March 2023 at Rusper Village Hall. The Full Council Meeting took place on the 28th February 2023 at Rusper Village Hall.

Reports from representatives:

WSCC Clir Katie Nagle took away request to follow up on a cycle route where the road narrows at the car park. Noted that there is a WSCC consultation on ANPR traffic violation fines until the end of March. District Councillor Liz Kitchen reported that local transport group for unlawful Gatwick airport parking which needs a Parish Council representative to join after the May election.

CIIr Hanstad-Pilcher - WSCC Highways have not responded to the second letter following the survey.

Clir Sallows – the sports club are looking at costs of resurfacing the second court.

Clir Cooke - The RPC website now has a diary page to put all Parish Council relevant meetings on.

CIIr Maitland-Smith has organised the regular annual litter pick via The Great British Clean promotion and Horsham District Council. This will be on 2nd April 2023, further details will be placed on the Rusper Parish website.

NPPF Levelling Up Consultation

The Rusper Parish Council response to this consultation was agreed and issued. Thanks were expressed to Cllr G Sallows for his work on the large document.

Rusper Sports Clubs Terms of Reference

The Sports Club terms of reference were written in draft form. This item is to be carried to the next meeting.

Procurement, Training, Funding Proposal

Councillors were tasked to take on Procurement, training and funding champion roles. This was agreed and Councillors were nominated to take on each role.

SAVE WEST OF IFIELD CAMPAIGN

You may have seen Homes England's recent report of their consultation in October/November last year. You can read the report here: Consultation Summary and Feedback Report.pdf SWOI is very concerned that the report does not fairly represent the balance of positive to negative comments made during the consultation. Our analysis of the published responses suggests that around 90% of comments were strongly negative – but this is not even hinted at in the report and instead the few positive comments are cherry-picked and presented prominently above any others. In other words, the fact that the written and verbal responses were overwhelmingly negative is ignored. This is misleading and disappointing from a government agency. It doesn't inspire confidence that any development promoted by Homes England will take account of local community views, let alone benefit existing residents.
